Instructions:

1. Please be at your assigned location 20-30 minutes before the service.

3. If you do not know the person you are greeting, introduce yourself first. Because you have shared something of yourself, they will feel more comfortable sharing information about themselves. Offer to walk them to the Welcome Center if they have any questions you can't answer. **Remember to wear your name tag!** (If you don't have a name tag please let Heidi know)
4. After the service, attempt to follow up with the new people you greeted before the service. Offer to walk with them to the fellowship hall for refreshments. Introduce guests to people of similar ages. Offer to introduce them to a pastor or leader of a ministry that might interest them.
